This year, we have a new electronic system for parents to use to log on themselves and make their own appointment. You will receive a text or email with details of how to access the system. We trialled it for Foundation Stage last summer and the feedback we had was that it was very simple to use and much more preferable to the old paper system. Please look out for a text and/or email coming towards the end of this week for you to book your slot.

As a school, we take the safeguarding of our schools very seriously and in particular the safety of our children when they are on-line. Due to the evergrowing popularity of the internet and social media, we have decided to take further action in ensuring our children are kept safe. On Friday 12th October, PCSO Izak will be in school leading some on-line safety sessions with Year 3 and Year 4 children in their classrooms.



Towards the end of this day, PCSO Izak will also deliver an online safety session for parents at 2:15pm in our small hall. We really urge you to please come along to this very important session which will hopefully raise your awareness of how to keep your child safe online and some of the resources that may help you.

This week at Forest School, Year 2 made a waffle fire. The children helped to collect sticks and we practised the safe kneeling position with the use of the fire circle. We all roasted marshmallows together at the end.









### **Health and Safety Notices**

Please could we remind parents not to bring dogs into the school grounds or in the close vicinity of the school where children may be. Even if the dogs are on a leash, there are children who can be extremely frightened of dogs causing distress to them.
